

Biography Aaron Neville

Born January 24, 1941, Aaron is the third of the four famous Neville Brothers of New Orleans. In 1966 he broke onto the national scene with “Tell It Like It Is,” the plaintive ballad that went #1 on the pop charts, a song still considered a classic in the annals of American music.

After firmly establishing a solo career, Aaron partnered with his brothers in 1977, and The Neville Brothers began their string of successful albums. Aaron says of his life’s work, “My folks taught me that music, love and God are all one thing. So in singing these standards—these romantic songs that get prettier with each passing year—I feel more than an earthly love. I feel the force of God, the spirit of all love.”

Aaron has won four Grammys and was named “Best Male Singer” two straight years in the Rolling Stone critics’ poll.
